

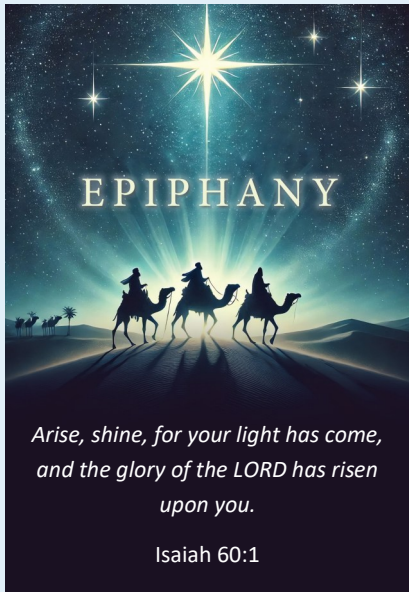

a message from senior pastor, Jacob Heine

Over the past couple of months we have looked at having a stable structure as we continue to do the work of living out our Guiding Statement -

{ As a vibrant family of believers, Faith Lutheran shares God's saving grace to equip the next generation. }

We need a stable structure. Four walls. Four corners. Four pillars on which to build and stand.

Proclaiming Christ Sharing Grace Equipping Generations Extending Mission

In the months ahead we will take the opportunity to explore a little bit what each of these pillars look like, why they are important, and how they work together with the other pillars. Our activities and programming all finding their basis and grounding in these pillars.

Last month we explored what it means to Proclaim Christ. We noted how this is an important thing for all of God's people to do, not just the paid church staff. Truly, the church staff is here to equip, teach, and show all members how to accomplish this task. But the Word of God goes out to more people because each member of the vibrant family of believers engages in Proclaiming Christ in their daily lives.

"Sharing Grace"

St. Paul's words to us in Ephesians 2 are powerful – *For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this is not from yourself, it is the gift of God-not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8 – 9)* The reminder that our life, work, and even more importantly, our status before God has nothing to do with our works. God has done the work for us. Christ Jesus coming to this world, living a perfect life for us, dying for the payment for our sins, and rising again to give us eternal life in a world that has no end is all God's work for us! This is grace! It isn't our work. It is God's work in Christ Jesus for our benefit.

This is a gift that we do not just keep to ourselves. It is a gift we share with others. As *God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works (Ephesians 2:10)* we naturally and eagerly share this wonderful gift that we have been given. Christ has forgiven you. He has shown you grace. You get to share that grace as you forgive others.

Christ has provided for your needs in His Sacraments – washing you of sin in water and word, feeding you with life giving body and blood through bread and wine. He has shown you grace. You get to share that grace with others as you help those who are struggling with physical needs in their lives and spiritual struggles.

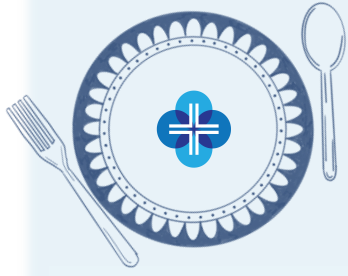
Christ brings His Word to you through Christ proclaimed—through Scripture read and faithfully expounded, through worship songs and hymns lifted in glory. In these moments, He meets you in a real and present way. He has shown you grace, and you are invited to share that grace as you tell others about the vibrant family of believers and all that God has done and provided for you.

I could go on and on, but I hope you see what I am seeing in these short examples. Those that receive grace can't help but share that grace. It is who we are. A vibrant family of believers who share God's saving grace.

As we begin a new year together, what better time to pray that God will show you how to share God's grace, and then act on what He leads you to!

November 2025... FLC treasurer update

- Total donations for the month were \$130,578 and total expenses were \$89,194, resulting in a net positive balance for the month of \$41,384.
- YTD donations total \$1,049,557 and YTD expenses total \$1,068,720, resulting in a net YTD negative balance of (\$19,172).
- Donations for the month were \$37,200 more than 2024 and YTD donations are \$24,047 more than 2024.
