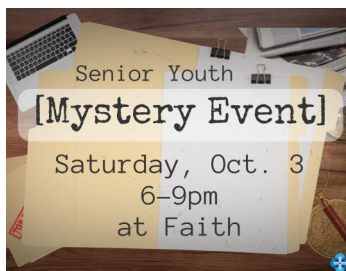

- Gently used clothing and shoes



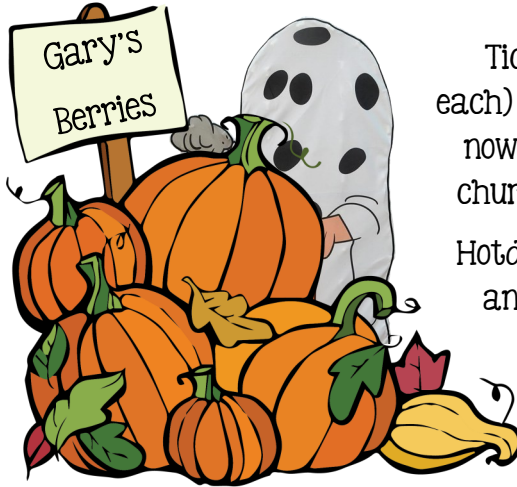
