✚ WORDS OF INSTITUTION & COMMUNION DISTRIBUTION

Prior to communing, we should all examine our hearts... Do you acknowledge your kinship with your brothers and sisters in Christ at this communion rail and do you set aside any refusal to forgive? Do you desire to live a God pleasing life? Are you aware of your sin and your need of God's forgiveness? If so, and you believe that Jesus is really present in the bread and wine through his body and blood, you may commune. Communion is given 'by station' in the front of the sanctuary. You will be ushered by pew. Clear grape juice is available in the center of the tray. Children are welcome to come up for a blessing. You may also bring your offering and place in the plate near the front, as you come forward for communion.
